- Scissors, tape or glue, and pipe cleaners

### Directions:

Cut the borders into 8 equal strips, link the strips together by looping them through each other and securing with tape. Once the chain is complete, glue a smiley cut-out onto the front of the chain for the caterpillar's face. Snip a pipe cleaner into two equal length pieces, and attach them with glue or tape onto the top of the accent for antennae. Give them some curl for cuteness.
