

Create crowns with letter pockets to use in spelling and language art games.

Materials Needed

1. Trimmers, any type
2. Alphabet Display Lettering, any type
3. Stapler
4. Sellotape
5. Ruler
6. Scissors



1. Provide one trimmer strip for each child. Cut for them, or have students cut the trimmer strip to the circumference of their heads plus 3cm. You can laminate the strips for added durability.
2. Form a circle (crown) with the trimmer by overlapping and stapling the two ends.
3. Punch out the letters. You can laminate the letters for extra durability.
4. Put letters, one at a time, onto the crown pocket and work together by lining up to spell words, or stand in alphabetical order.

The numerals that come with the letters can be used with the crowns to count.
