

Create tactile letters to aid in learning letter name and shape.

Materials Needed

1. Alphabet Display Letters, any type
2. Glue stick
3. Paintbrush
4. Fine sand, seeds, cereal, beads, etc
5. Newspaper



1. Spread out the newspaper to cover the work surface.
2. Punch out one of each uppercase and/or lowercase letters and place them colored side up on the newsprint.
3. Using the paintbrush, spread glue over the colored face of one letter.
4. Sprinkle or align sand, seeds, cereal, or other product lightly over the glue. Set letter aside to dry.
5. Continue with each letter until all are coated with the textured material.
6. After the glue dries, shake off the excess material. Then paint over the letter with a glue and water mixture to seal and prevent flaking.
