Create an organised classroom with the help of these cute name and job tags. As name tags they are great for the first day of school and for learning names. As job tags they play an important role in organising classroom routines. Students quickly learn about responsibility and will wear their role tags proudly.

Nifty Name or Job Tags

You will need:

- Thick wool, tape, scissors and a marker pen.

Directions:

For sturdy lanyards, braid three pieces of thick wool together, ensuring that it is long enough for students to wear around their necks. When you reach the desired length, bring the two ends of the braid together and knot them, leaving an inch or so of unbraided wool after the knot. Fluff the ends for a fun fringe. For name tags, use the mini accents and write "Who am I?" across the top and the student's name across the cut outs middle.

For job tags, do the same again and write the task across the middle, like "Fish Feeder".

Attach the completed accents to the lanyards with tape, covering the knots.
